survived out of 102 when the pilgrims landed in america the indians began to squabble between each other acting as a go between as tempers escalated squanto was quoted as saying we live on the same earth we live under the same moon we breathe the same air why can t we get along for the next fifty years harmony existed between the settlers and the indians
